

## Advanced Placement Courses as Demonstrations of Proficiency for Graduation Requirements

Scores on Advanced Placement (AP) course exams of 2 or above can be used as demonstrations of Mathematics or English proficiency for graduation requirements.

AP course exams are offered in May of each school year. Exam scores are not made available to schools and students until late summer. Seniors taking AP courses will not have exam results prior to graduation and therefore will not be able to use the exam scores as demonstrations of proficiency for graduation. Students wishing to use AP exam scores as demonstrations of proficiency for graduation should plan course registration accordingly.
