Please have the following items available when coming to your scheduled appointment.

1. IRS Form W2
2. IRS Form 1099-misc. 1099-div, 1099-int and/or 1099-b (if any)
3. IRS Form 1095 & Health Insurance card for all members of the household
4. Colorado Driver's license or state issued ID
5. Social Security cards for all people listed on the tax return – including dependents
6. Receipts for child care expenses including – provider name, address, phone, EIN and amount paid
7. Medical records or school records substantiating dependency support
8. For those that are self employed we will need receipts for all business expenses.
